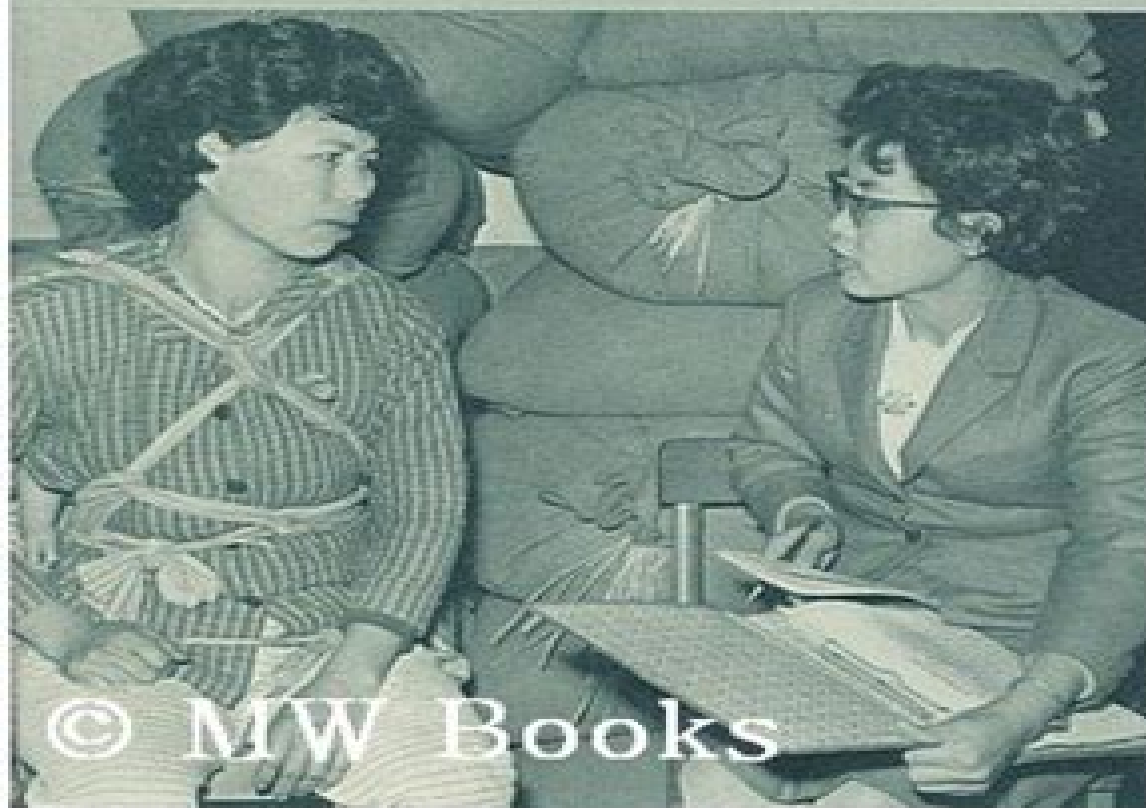

In the crucial area of the demography of developing nations, the experimental family planning program in Taichung, the provincial capital of Taiwan, is a landmark. When this project began in 1963, it was the largest intensive program of its kind ever to be carried out for a stable, concentrated population. Moreover, it was unique among such social experiments in its systematic observation and measurements, which have resulted in an unusually detailed picture of the correlates and consequences of a family planning program.

These data are presented here, together with a preliminary analysis of the conditions existing at the time the program was founded. A fertility decline was already underway in Taiwan in 1963, and the aim was both to accelerate this decline by making family planning services available to couples who wanted them and to test the feasibility of certain aspects of a large-scale organized program. The immediate success of the effort, and particularly the strong interest shown by the population, soon led to the extension of the program to all of Taiwan.

In evaluating the program and its effects, the authors seek to establish the extent to which the changes in Taiwan's fertility level resulted from
