Los estudios aquí presentados reflejan sin duda la evolución que la propia sociedad ha experimentado en estos últimos cincuenta años y exploran la relación entre las prácticas culturales la vida diaria y los contextos económicos políticos e históricos. No es de extrañar que una gran parte de las contribuciones presentadas en este volumen se centren en el estudio de la lengua ya que la demanda del inglés se ha incrementado de forma considerable en los últimos años.
