by the mid eleventh century a wealthy unified better organized better educated more spiritually sensitive Latin Church was assuming a leading place in the broader Christian world Before the Gregorian Reform challenges us to rethink the history of the Church and its place in the broader narrative of European history Compellingly written and generously illustrated it is a book for all medievalists as well as general readers interested in the Middle Ages and Church history
