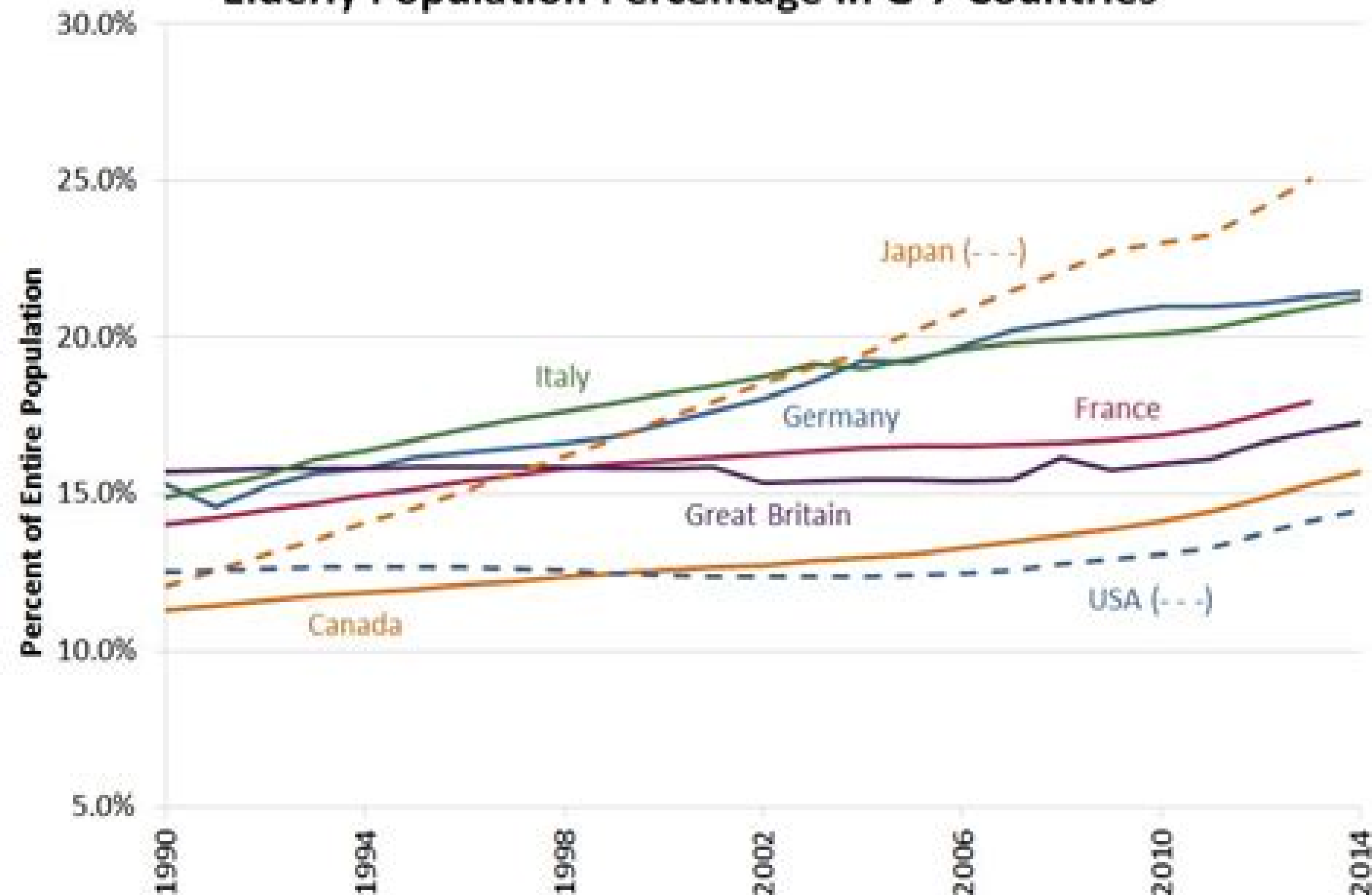


Elderly Population Percentage in G-7 Countries
