Anthony was an ardent abolitionist from day one and she spent much of the first 40 years of her life championing the cause of African Americans even befriending men like Frederick Douglass and William Lloyd Garrison along the way She also championed radical ideas as 8 hour work days minimum wage laws and equal pay for women Susan B.
