Beard, 2016-04-26 News of Alzheimer s disease is constantly in the headlines Every day we hear heart wrenching stories of people caring for a loved one who has become a shell of their former self of projections about rising incidence rates and of cures that are just around the corner However we don t see or hear from the people who actually have the disease In Living with Alzheimer s Ren e L Beard argues that the exclusively negative portrayals of Alzheimer s are grossly inaccurate To understand what life with memory loss is really like Beard draws on intensive observations of nearly 100 seniors undergoing cognitive evaluation as well as post diagnosis interviews with individuals experiencing late in life forgetfulness Since we all forget sometimes seniors with an Alzheimer s diagnosis ultimately need to be socialized into medicalized interpretations of their forgetfulness In daily life people with the disease are forced to manage stigma and the presumption of incompetence on top of the actual symptoms of their ailment The well meaning public and not their dementia becomes the major barrier to a

happy life for those affected Beard also examines how these perceptions affect treatment for Alzheimer's Interviews with clinicians and staff from the Alzheimer's Association reveal that despite the best of intentions pejorative framings of life with dementia fuel both clinical practice and advocacy efforts These professionals perpetuate narratives about self loss impending cures and the economic and emotional burden to families and society even if they do not personally believe them Yet Beard also concludes that in spite of these trends most of the diagnosed individuals in her study achieve a graceful balance between accepting the medical label and resisting the social stigma that accompanies it In stark contrast to the messages we receive this book provides an unprecedented view into the ways that people with early Alzheimer's actively and deliberately navigate their lives

Managing to Care Ann E. P. Dill, The point of departure for *Managing to Care* is widespread concern that the present delivery of health and social welfare services is fragmented uncoordinated inefficient costly wasteful and ultimately detrimental to clients health and wellbeing Dill traces the evolution of case management from its start as a tool for integrating services on the level of the individual client to its current role as a force behind the most significant trends in health care Those trends include the entrenchment of bureaucracy the challenges of once dominant professions and the rise of corporate control The author's purpose in adopting this analysis is to invite further scrutiny of the case management profession and at the same time to identify new possibilities for its application This volume brings together thoughts developed over many years of observing and participating in case management programs It provides a multilayered perspective of case management showing linkages among its social and historical contexts and the ways it is practiced today in diverse service settings The author emerged convinced about the essential need for care coordination and that present ways of providing care can work against our highest objectives in doing so The paradoxes and contraindications embedded in case management practice became a major theme of the book *Managing to Care* is highly critical of the ways case management has come to absorb and reflect the organizational flaws of the very service systems it was intended to reform Too often management of the case comes to dominate care The author does not call for a rejection of professional systems in favor of a resurrected informal community While much can and should be done to strengthen our ties to one another there will always be people whose problems require more expert help Dill argues here that case management can provide such help and provide it well but only if it is grounded in the human dimension of a caring relationship Ann E P Dill associate professor of sociology and gender studies at Brown University is a medical sociologist and social gerontologist Her research examines issues affecting the long term provision of health care and social services both in the United States and in countries formerly part of Yugoslavia

Bogard, 2003 Homelessness had become a social problem that was primarily not about solving the nation's housing crisis The pressing question becomes How and why did homelessness become the social problem in its own right one that was only tangentially related to the problem of inappropriate or insufficient housing Why when people demanded that something be done about homelessness did they get specific policies and unintended outcomes Cynthia Bogard is not content with the shorthand answers that rested on bias and ideology such as conservative politics bred conservative policies or American individualism precludes government investment in housing This did not explain homelessness sufficiently especially given all the advocacy and research that had occurred in the 1980s and 1990s Examining these claimsmaking activities as constructionists call them however is a daunting task because the activities engaged in by people in the attempt to persuade others are fluid subtle and complicated as are the responses to these social actions This raised a second set of issues that the author is concerned with How can we adequately represent and sociologically examine this very complicated human activity of social problems construction Who does the construction and to what effect Bogard's answer to these questions is a book that can be read in two ways and on multiple levels For those who are interested in the story of the career of homelessness as a social problem in America's two national cities the book should be read from the beginning through the conclusion as a straight narrative The technical matter in the appendix can be ignored But for those readers with an interest in social problems constructionism however this book is meant as a cook book of sorts Each chapter emphasizes a feature of constructionism such as an important group of claims makers or an important aspect of the claims making process The work highlights a major feature in advanced societies the intersection of interests and claims Social constructions may be real but they are comprised of no less real social interests The work marks a real departure and advance over the original formulations of construction theory in social research Cynthia J Bogard is associate professor of sociology at Hofstra University

The Fight Against Big Tobacco Mark Wolfson, 2017-07-12 Tobacco control leaders were extremely proud of the movement's achievements in the state of Minnesota In sharing their perspectives and experiences with Mark Wolfson they found a way of making sure that the story would get told His training in social movements had given him an appreciation of the importance of understanding the social infrastructure on which movements are built and Minnesota had built heavily on the infrastructure of health care and public

Qualitative researchers have traditionally been cautious about claiming that their work was scientific The right on schools have exaggerated this caution into an outright rejection of science as a model for their work Science is for them outmoded an archaic form of consciousness surviving for a while yet in a degraded form Tyler 1986 200 Scientists assertions that they are in pursuit of truth simply camouflage their own lust for power There is no essential difference between truth and propaganda The authors acknowledge that the boundary between science and propaganda has often been breached and some distrust of scientific claims may be healthy They also question the claim that science creates disinterested and objective knowledge of an observer independent world without concluding that science is impossible The skeptics reservations about qualitative research are based on the deep rooted assumption among natural scientists and some social scientists that there is a world out there prior to and independent of their observations This world can be known objectively in the sense that all observers will if identically placed see it in exactly the same way If a suitable language were available they would also all produce identical descriptions From these observations they can work out the laws governing the world s operations The authors try to resolve these contrary claims by asserting that science is a procedural commitment It consists of openness to refutation a conscientious and systematic search for contradictory evidence and a readiness to subject one s preconceptions to critical examination The devotion to truth as a regulative ideal is an essential difference between science and propaganda This work is a unique and innovative defense of scientific method **Fathoming the Holocaust** Ronald J. Berger, Fathoming the Holocaust represents the culmination of a singular effort to attempt to explain the Final Solution to the Jewish Problem in terms of a general theory of social problems construction The book is comprehensive in scope covering the origins and emergence of the Final Solution wartime reaction to it and the postwar memory of the genocide It does so within the

framework of a social problems construction a perspective that treats social problems not as a condition but as an activity that identifies and defines problems persuades others that something must be done about them and generates practical programs of remedial action Berger holds that social problems have a natural history that is they evolve through a sequence of stages that entail the development and unfolding of claims about problems and the formulation and implementation of solutions Fathoming the Holocaust is therefore a book that aims to advance sociological understanding of the Holocaust not simply to describe its history but to examine its social construction that is to understand it as a consequence of concerted human activity In doing so Berger hopes to encourage the teaching of the Holocaust in the social scientific curricula of higher education In contrast to the extensive historical literature on the Holocaust Berger offers a distinctly sociological approach that examines how the Holocaust was constructed first as a social policy designed by the Nazis implemented by functionaries and resisted by its victims and opponents later as several varying layers of historical memory The scope of this book extends from the prewar through the contemporary periods focusing on the societal issues governing the interpreting of these events in Israel the German Federal Republic and the United States Berger's is a text with both large general interest and essential material for courses in social problems European history and Jewish studies Ronald J Berger professor of sociology at the University of Wisconsin Whitewater has previously published six books and numerous articles and book chapters His earlier book on the Holocaust was a sociological account of his father and uncle's survival experiences

Entitlement Politics David G. Smith, *Entitlement Politics* describes partisan attempts to shrink the size of government by targeting two major federal health care entitlements Efforts to restructure or eliminate entitlements as such and to privatize and decentralize programs along with more traditional attempts to amend and reform Medicare and Medicaid have radically transformed policymaking with respect to these programs However they have failed to achieve fundamental or lasting reform Smith combines historical narrative and case studies with descriptions of the technical aspects and dynamics of policymaking to help the consumer understand how the process has changed evaluate particular policies and outcomes and anticipate future possibilities His account intentionally goes at some length into the substance of the programs the policies that are involved and the views of different protagonists about the major issues in the dispute One unhealthy consequence of politicizing Medicare and Medicaid policy has been to separate public debate from the technical and organizational realities underlying issues of cost containment or program structure Smith considers this development unfortunate since it leaves even informed citizens unable to evaluate the claims being made Ironically strife over Medicare has complicated the political and policy issues in American life Only a serious and genuine bipartisan effort bringing forth the best efforts of both political parties and some of the best industry leaders and policy experts in the field is likely to achieve genuine reform The more people and parties know about the history politics and policies of these programs the better our prospects for devising workable equitable and lasting solutions This volume leads the way toward that understanding David

G Smith is Richter Professor Emeritus of Political Science at Swarthmore College and has been a student of health policy since 1965. Among his books is an earlier study of health policy *Paying for Medicare*. **Using Murder** Philip Jenkins, 2017-09-08.
