Reverberating Song in Shakespeare and Milton Erin Minear, 2016-04-08 In this study Erin Minear explores the fascination of Shakespeare and Milton with the ability of music heard, imagined or remembered to infiltrate language. Such infected language reproduces not so much the formal or sonic properties of music as its effects. Shakespeare's and Milton's understanding of these effects was determined, she argues, by history and culture as well as individual sensibility.
