Peter Hayes and Kirk Smith (eds), The Global Greenhouse Regime: Who Pays? Science, economics and North-South politics in the Climate Change Convention. Tokyo: United Nations University Press; London: Earthscan, 1993. xv + 382pp. £24.95 paperback.

The Climate Change Convention agreed to in Rio de Janeiro in 1992 is still largely symbolic, and must be succeeded by protocols and firm abatement agreements yet to be negotiated. This book sets itself the ambitious task of providing a basis for negotiating such a protocol under Article 5 of the Convention which states 'that the developed countries ... shall take all practicable steps to promote, facilitate and finance, as appropriate, the transfer of, or access to, environmentally sound technologies and know-how to the developing countries to enable them to implement the provisions of the Convention'. The book discusses and develops: (i) measures to assess greenhouse gas emissions; (ii) criteria, involving accountability, equity and efficiency yardsticks for who should pay; (iii) North-South carbon marginal abatement cost curves; and (iv) transfer mechanisms and burden sharing arrangements. In doing so it thus provides a good part of the staff work for the initial substantive agenda for the political negotiations which should take place, regardless of the time span it may take to negotiate the relevant protocol under the Convention.

Measures of responsibilities for climate change include indices for levels of current emissions as well as of cumulative emissions. Radiative forcing of greenhouse gases (relative strength of gases) and atmospheric residence times (duration) together impact on climate change, and in choosing this measure, the main responsibility to pay necessarily falls on the developed countries. While carbon dioxide accounts for only half of the greenhouse gases and may be even less harmful than other gases, the information base is relatively better developed and the link with fossil fuel and energy planning is well established. Hence it is a suitable basis to start negotiating an international protocol. Attempts are made to develop marginal abatement cost curves, following the work of Nordhaus and the US National Academy of Science, which would indicate where abatement expenditures are most cost effective. Thus, the stage is set for an international funding mechanism and an allocation mechanism, involving three blocks of countries: the North, the South and the East, the formerly centrally planned economies of Eastern Europe and the CIS. In the final chapter, the type of problems to be encountered during the negotiating process are examined, and an attempt is made to try to draw some lessons from other international North-South negotiating ventures which have taken some decades. The book does not discuss as yet tradeable emissions for carbon dioxide abatement, though it suggests that there is scope for such a trade to develop in future as the developed countries may be hitting the sharply rising part of the marginal abatement cost curve shortly, while many developing countries may still be at the initial flat stage of the curves, where abatement will be most cost-effective on a global scale.

Any such ambitious international new transfer mechanism for greenhouse gas abatement is unlikely to come about until the paying regions are convinced that there is a coherent energy sector supply and demand policy in prospective recipient countries, to which the international community could provide assistance: otherwise, it would amount to committing money to a bottomless pit, which is not a sustainable basis for the transfer mechanism in the Climate Convention. In Part III of the book the results of six country/regional case studies are provided of greenhouse abatement strategy development. This generally requires the analysis of scenarios for the changing primary fuel generation mix, the pattern of energy consumption and an assessment of the possibilities and effectiveness of abatement strategies and measures in each of
