Denham, 2018-09-05 Robert D Denham pursues his quest to uncover the links between Northrop Frye and writers and others who directly influenced his thinking but about whom he did not write an extensive commentary The first chapter is about Frye s reading of Patanjali the founder of the philosophy of Hindu yoga while the second discusses cultural mythographer Giambattista Vico literary history and poetic language The focus of Frye s criticism was the verbal arts but he also had an abiding interest in both the visual arts and music hence Frye s admiration of J S Bach The essay on Tolkien examines the tendency in literary history to return from irony to myth as well as the role that Tolkien played in Frye s fiction writing fantasies In subsequent chapters Denham explores Frye s preference for romance and his critique of realism which run parallel to the views of Oscar Wilde and their strong shared convictions about the centripetal thrust of art and about criticism being as creative as literature Frye s appreciation for Whitehead s concept of interpenetration in *Science in the Modern World* became a key feature of Frye s speculations about the highest reaches of literature and religion Frye is clearly indebted to Martin Buber particularly his influential meditation *I and Thou* Aristotle an important influence upon Frye was partially filtered through R S Crane and his *The Languages of Criticism and the Structure of Poetry* Finally the relationship between Frye and his Oxford tutor Edmund Blunden are explored while the last is an essay on Frye and M H Abrams on how Frye s critical project might be viewed developed in Abrams s *The Mirror and the Lamp* This book is published in English Robert D Denham poursuit son examen dcrivains et autres influences qui ont marqu l

Virtuous Bodies Susanne Mrozik, 2007-07-20 *Virtuous Bodies* breaks new ground in the field of Buddhist ethics by investigating the diverse roles bodies play in ethical development. Traditionally Buddhists assumed a close connection between body and morality. Thus Buddhist literature contains descriptions of living beings that stink with sin, are disfigured by vices, or are perfumed and adorned with virtues. Most strikingly, bodies also function as instruments for the ethical development of others. When living beings come into contact with the virtuous bodies of bodhisattvas, they are transformed physically and morally for the better. *Virtuous Bodies* explores both the centrality of bodies to the bodhisattva ideal and the corporeal specificity of that ideal. Arguing that the bodhisattva ideal is an embodied ethical ideal, Mrozik poses an array of fascinating questions: What does virtue look like? What kinds of physical features constitute virtuous bodies? What kinds of bodies have virtuous effects on others? Drawing on a range of contemporary theorists, this book engages in a feminist hermeneutics of recovery and suspicion in order to explore the ethical resources Buddhism offers to scholars and religious practitioners interested in the embodied nature of ethical ideals. *Jōkei and Buddhist Devotion in Early Medieval Japan* James L. Although Jikaku is invariably cited as one of the leading representatives of established Buddhism during the Kamakura period, he has been seriously neglected by Western scholars. In this book, James L. Ford aims to shed light on this pivotal and long overlooked figure. Ford argues convincingly that Jikaku is an ideal personage through which to peer anew into the socio-religious dynamics of early medieval Japan. Indeed, Jikaku is uniquely linked to a number of decisive trends and issues of dispute, including the conflict between the established schools and Hnen's exclusive nenbutsu movement, the precept revival movement, doctrinal reform efforts, the proliferation of prominent reclusive monks (tonseis), the escalation of fundraising (kanjin) campaigns and popular propagation, and the conspicuous revival of devotion toward Sakyamuni and Maitreya. Jikaku represents a paradigm within established Buddhism that recognized the necessity of accessing other powers through esoteric practices, ritual performances, and objects of devotion. While Jikaku is best known as a leading critic of Hnen's exclusive nenbutsu movement and a conservative defender of normative Buddhist principles, he was also a progressive reformer in his own right. Far from defending the status quo, Jikaku envisioned a more accessible, harmonious, and monastically upright form of Buddhism. Through a detailed examination of Jikaku's extensive writings and activities, Ford challenges many received interpretations of Jikaku's legacy and the transformation of Buddhism in early medieval Japan. This book fills a significant lacuna in Buddhist scholarship.
