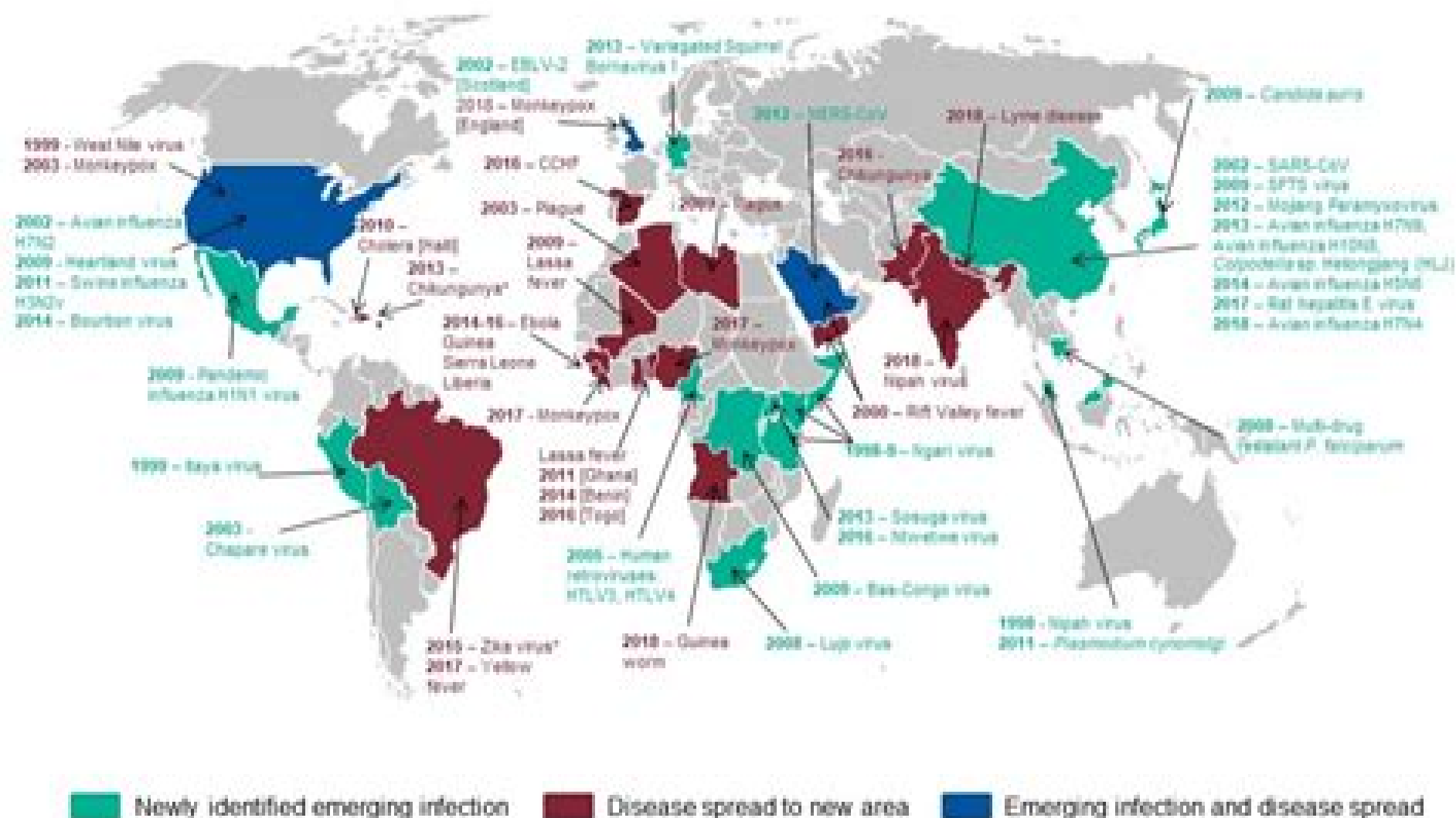


Global map of significant and new emerging infections in humans: spread to new areas since 1998
