Early Greeks to Descartes to James considered basic emotions. Cognitive interpretations of stimulus changes determine emotions.

### C. Emotion as Impulses for Action and Thought

Action readiness: impulse to action of emotion-relevant behavior. Motor explosion: nonadaptive response, e.g., jump for joy.

### D. Physiological Arousal

It serves as the basis for feelings and action readiness for emotions.

### E. Facial Expression

As indicator of emotional feelings.

As signals used to satisfy social motives.

Facial feedback hypothesis: pattern of facial muscles is informational basis for emotional feelings.
