Economic Incentives for Marine and Coastal Conservation Essam Yassin Mohammed, 2013-11-26 Marine and coastal resources provide millions of people with their livelihoods such as fishing and tourism and a range of critical additional ecosystem services from biodiversity and culture to carbon storage and flood protection Yet across the world these resources are fast diminishing under the weight of pollution land clearance coastal development overfishing natural disasters and climate change This book shows how economic instruments can be used to incentivize the conservation of marine and coastal resources It is shown that traditional approaches to halt the decline focus on regulating against destructive practices but to little effect A more successful strategy could be to establish schemes such as payments for ecosystem services PES or incorporate an element of financial incentives into existing regulatory mechanisms Examples both terrestrial and marine from across the world suggest that PES can work to protect both livelihoods and environments But to succeed it is shown that these schemes must be underpinned by robust research clear property rights sound governance structures equitable benefit sharing and sustainable finance Case studies are included from south and east Asia Latin America Africa and Australia The book explores the prospects and challenges and draws lessons from PES and PES like programmes from across the globe

The WTO, Agriculture and Sustainable Development Heinrich Wohlmeyer, Theodor Quendler, 2017-09-08 Despite the Doha declaration of November 2001 the failure to start a new round of global trade negotiations at Seattle in December 1999 and the hostility of protesters to the trade liberalization process and growing global economic and social disparities was a wake up call for the World Trade Organisation WTO The ambitious goal of this ground breaking book is to identify the strengths and weaknesses of liberalized world trade in particular in the agricultural sector and to investigate to what extent the current WTO agreements provide the necessary fail safe devices to react to trade related negative impacts on sustainability environmental protection and food security The background and interrelationship between the WTO the tenets of sustainable development and the unique features of the agriculture and forestry sectors are explored and conclusions regarding the deficits of the world trade system and its conflicts with basic societal goals such as sustainability are drawn Agriculture and forestry have a particular affinity with what the authors call strong sustainability and are to be among the major agenda items in forthcoming WTO negotiations The book proposes that sustainable agricultural production techniques such as integrated and organic farming provide a series of related services to community and environment which could be severely prejudiced by wholesale trade liberalization and the imposition of the large scale production methods of the mega trade giants of the USA and Europe And yet the concept of sustainability is referred to only tangentially in the existing WTO agenda The WTO Agriculture and Sustainable Development argues that without a formal recognition of this failing the premise that free trade is inherently advantageous for all countries is a falsehood Further unfettered liberalization is unsustainable and a social and environmental multilateral framework must be agreed to reinterpret or adapt a host of WTO

regulations that are at odds with sustainable development The core problem is that under the current system import duties can only be differentiated by direct goods and services and not by their means of production sustainable or otherwise Therefore a range of environmental policy measures in the agricultural sector such as the consideration of product life cycles the internalization of external costs and a coupling of trade liberalization with ecological obligations are proposed by the authors In addition they argue that unsustainable economic short termism must be curbed and the use of the stick of trade sanctions and the carrot of financial benefits for good environmental performance be permitted to promote sustainable agricultural practices This book will contribute greatly in addressing the lack of basic theoretical arguments at the intersection between trade and sustainable development a failing that has already been bemoaned by trade policy makers It is highly recommended reading for all those involved or interested in the WTO negotiations whether from multilateral organizations governments industry or civil society

International Labor Migration and Livelihood Security in Nepal Knerr, Beatrice,2017-07-11 As measured by its per capita income Nepal is one of the poorest countries in the world with large parts of its population trapped in poverty within a stunning but difficult to control natural environment Under these conditions since the wake of the 21st century international labour migration and the associated remittances of large amounts of foreign exchange have rapidly gained influence on the country s economic and social development triggered by internal disturbances in particular economic downturn and political upheavals as well as external dynamics which boosted an uprising international demand for unskilled labour While there is hardly any basic dissent about the short to mid term Positive growth effect for Nepal s economy surprisingly little is known about the consequences of this form of livelihood security at the individual household level apart from some anecdotal evidence although neither policy makers nor NGOs may effectively craft their strategies without considering this phenomenon This book was developed from an Alumni Workshop held in Kathmandu in 2015 where focusing on this knowledge gap wide
