Emeric Pressburger Kevin Macdonald, 1994-01-01 A Hungarian Jew who lived and worked in half a dozen European countries before arriving in Britain in 1935 Pressburger's reputation rests on the series of strikingly original films he made in collaboration with Michael Powell under the banner of The Archers A Matter of Life and Death Ian Christie, 2021-10-21 Produced in the aftermath of the Second World War Michael Powell and Emeric Pressburger's A Matter of Life and Death 1946 stars David Niven as an RAF pilot poised between life and death his love for the American radio operator June Kim Hunter threatened by medical political and ultimately celestial forces.
