Empiricism is a philosophical and scientific concept that emphasizes the role of experience, evidence, and observation in the formation of knowledge.

DEFINITION

Empiricism asserts that knowledge is best gained through sensory experience. As a result, we should engage in experimentation to gain knowledge rather than relying exclusively on reason or intuition. This concept underpins the scientific method and has been applied across disciplines, including science, psychology, and economics.

EXAMPLES

- **Observational studies:** In observational studies, researchers observe and record behaviors or phenomena to test their hypotheses.

Moreover, it claims that eliminating the thing in itself as the ultimate object of knowledge is not to admit idealism but in fact is the only way to consistently uphold realism. In addition, the book also addresses the question why assuming that the proposed interpretation is correct, Kant had chosen not to make his true intentions clear.
