- The "father" of classical economics.
- Published what is referred to as the first book on modern economics; *An Inquiry into the Nature and Causes of the Wealth of Nations*.
- His book completely changed the way economic activity was understood.
- It became the backbone of economic theory for classical school until later in the 19th century.
- His observations form the basis of many theories we study today, despite the changes since the 18th century.
