Effect sizes for research: A broad practical approach

Many would agree that a p -value lower than .05 can no longer be the only aim of an experienced researcher. Effect size measures and a thorough understanding of them represent an already important part of modern psychological research. Task forces encourage the use of effect size measures (Wilkinson, 1999), journal editors require them and meta-analysts employ them. In the past decade, effect size indexes have become a requirement in empirical research.

The book by Grissom and Kim provides a practical overview of several effect size indexes and measures for a broad set of statistical applications. The book covers the use of effect size indexes with applications ranging from the simple two-group comparison of means to factorial designs, including cases with continuous, ordinal and categorical variables. The organization of the book is based on variable types and complexity of research design. Starting with a general conceptual overview of effect size measures (chapter 1), the authors address the two-group means comparison (chapters 2, 3 and 4), continuous variables (chapter 5), one-way designs (chapter 6), factorial designs (chapter 7), and then extend the treatment to categorical (chapter 8) and ordinal variables (chapter 9).

This book can be a valuable companion for graduate students and researchers, with or without a strong statistical background. The book explains the basics of many different effect size measures, provides clear information about their applicability and supports the discussion with a wide and complete list of references from the relevant statistical literature. Although not meant for experts working on the mathematical underpinning of effect size measures, the accurate coverage of the latest literature could be of great value to advanced readers too.

This book has many attractive features. For each research design considered in the book, the authors present alternative approaches to quantify effects, explaining the differences and similarities between them. The assumptions underlying each approach are discussed in detail, and alternative courses of action are presented to circumvent troublesome assumptions. Worked examples are abundant, making the book easy to follow, even for students and researchers with a weak statistical background. When different effect size measures are discussed, compared, and their assumptions clarified, 'tentative recommendations' are outlined, such that the reader is not left alone in deciding which measure fits best in each particular case. Finally, the book presents a good treatment of confidence intervals for effect size measures. Confidence intervals bring probability back to the effect size discussion and are a fundamental complement to any quantification of effects.

Presenting alternative approaches to the same problem is a positive feature of any statistical book, but it is particularly important for a book about effect sizes. Effect size measures, in fact, have been promoted after decades of criticisms of researchers' reliance on null hypothesis testing (cf. Cohen, 1994). The idea of promoting the use of effect size aims at encouraging researchers to think more on the practical importance of their statistical effects, rather than rely on automatic rules such as rejecting or not the null hypothesis. This reform of statistical thinking, however, can only work if effect sizes are discussed in a critical way, compared, and used to extract the most relevant characteristics of the data. If researchers simply append a number (usually Cohen's d or eta-squared) to a p -value, we end up with two automatic rules, instead of one. This book can help researchers to follow the right path.
