attending parliament that it was for a knight of the shires But because parliament was already packed with lawyers it was difficult to make any such rule stick Then an effective way of excluding them was found They were denied the wages paid to members in those days Sadly these days parliament and the government are packed with lawyers once again And they are being paid A law passed in 1540 and still in force today makes it illegal for barbers in the City of London to practise surgery with impeccable impartiality the Act also forbids surgeons to cut hair Finally never forget that under the Vagrancy Act of 1824 you can be convicted of being an idle and disorderly person or a rogue vagabond or incorrigible rogue The same act also outlaws people professing to tell fortunes including palmistry Under the Act it is an offence merely to be suspected
