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Medicina, ideología e historia en España (siglos XVI-XXI) Ricardo Campos Marín, 2007 En el terreno que nos ocupa el de la medicina parece evidente que los aspectos ideológicos se han ido disolviendo en una creciente tecnificación de la práctica de la misma donde la relación entre el médico y el paciente está mediatizada por un entramado científico técnico abrumador A su vez las campañas sanitarias centradas en los conceptos de riesgo y en los estilos de vida saludables se han vaciado aparentemente pero sólo aparentemente de cualquier atisbo ideológico utilizando la estadística como instrumento objetivo que avala científicamente las actuaciones propuestas A esto hay que añadir la internalización por parte de los ciudadanos de la salud como un valor que estructura nuestras vidas Precisamente esa asunción de la salud como un valor aceptado por la población contribuye de manera importante a sustraer a la medicina de sus implicaciones ideológicas El conjunto de trabajos que forman este volumen indaga en las relaciones entre medicina ideología e historia mostrando cómo se han ido configurando en el tiempo los conceptos de salud y enfermedad y cómo ambos no han sido nunca elementos neutrales También se explora el papel de la medicina en la construcción de identidades y en la catalogación de los individuos cuestiones íntimamente ligadas a la ideología Por último los diferentes proyectos y concepciones de la medicina y salud están presentes en varios ensayos de este volumen El origen del mismo está en el XIII Congreso de la Sociedad Española de Historia de la Medicina celebrado en Madrid entre los días 15 y 17 de septiembre de 2005 en la Facultad de Medicina de la Universidad Complutense de Madrid y en el Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas bajo el lema La condición histórica de la medicina El libro pues es representativo del amplio panorama por el que se mueve la historiografía de la medicina en nuestro país en este comienzo de siglo

Edición y literatura en España (siglos XVI y XVII) Anne Cayuela, 2012-12-31 Edición y literatura en España siglos XVI y XVII reúne una colección de diecisiete artículos de destacados especialistas en literatura española del Siglo de Oro y en Historia de la cultura escrita En el marco de una reflexión pluridisciplinar se estudian conjuntamente las condiciones de publicación y de difusión de las obras literarias en el Siglo de Oro y la significación de los textos El interés por la materialidad del libro antiguo en sus aspectos técnicos más diversos permite arrojar luz sobre las condiciones de producción y de recepción de los textos Esta reflexión sobre la práctica editorial en los siglos XVI y XVII y en particular sobre el papel de autor y la implicación de los diferentes agentes así como las intervenciones sobre el texto son algunas de las cuestiones principales que se abordan También se interroga el papel del espacio material del libro antiguo en el estudio de la textualidad con el fin de destacar el conjunto de elementos que condicionan la lectura y favorecen el acceso al sentido Además del intento de reconstitución del paso del texto por la imprenta el libro propone una reflexión sobre la edición de obras clásicas en la actualidad teniendo en cuenta las nuevas herramientas de difusión

conquistador español. Se ocupa de los clérigos y religiosos cuyos usos y costumbres han quedado registrados tanto en las deposiciones de los acusadores como en las de los acusados. Artesanos. Una historia social en España (siglos XVI-XIX) Francisco Hidalgo Fernández, José Antolín Nieto Sánchez, En *Artesanos Una historia social en España siglos XVI-XIX* se integran un conjunto de contribuciones que tienen a los artesanos y las artesanas de la Edad Moderna y primera contemporaneidad como objeto de estudio. Reconociendo las nuevas perspectivas y aportaciones de la historia social y la historia del trabajo manufacturero la obra tiene como objetivo reunir a un conjunto de especialistas en las diferentes líneas de investigación llevadas a cabo por la historiografía española de los últimos años sobre el artesanado. Es una puesta al día en la materia pero también un punto de inicio de investigaciones que podrán desarrollarse al calor de las reflexiones, perspectivas, temáticas y conclusiones elaboradas a lo largo de estas páginas. Entre los temas desarrollados: nuevas categorías y retos conceptuales, mercados profesionales, marcados por características propias de acuerdo con el espacio pero también con cronologías particulares, el aprendizaje gremial, los movimientos migratorios, la participación de las mujeres en las actividades de producción, la conflictividad laboral o el corporativismo artesano en el XIX. En suma, la obra es un alto en el camino que nos permite debatir y pensar antes de continuar trabajando en un mundo laboral moderno repleto de aristas, contradicciones, estereotipos y tópicos todavía por superar.

Pocos temas nos conciernen más en la actualidad que el proceso de envejecimiento de la población y sus consecuencias. Tanto a nivel individual como colectivo sus efectos comienzan a ser bien perceptibles en España. Ante su trascendencia es lógico que los investigadores presten cada vez mayor atención a la vejez. No es muy frecuente sin embargo reunir en un mismo libro a historiadores, sociólogos, antropólogos, demógrafos, psicólogos y médicos para que nos iluminen sobre algunas de sus múltiples implicaciones. El tema se ha planteado además en la larga duración para evitar caer en la miopía de lo inmediato y poder comprender en toda su dimensión la complejidad del problema.

Familias, experiencias de cambio y movilidad social en España (siglos XVI-XIX) Francisco García González, Francisco Chacón Jiménez, 2020-07-24. Con este libro se pretende enriquecer la comprensión del cambio social en períodos de transición como la Edad Moderna y la crisis del Antiguo Régimen. Problemática que en buena parte de los textos aquí reunidos convierte el estudio de la movilidad social en su hilo conductor. Para ello se ponen en práctica algunos de los recursos metodológicos propios de la nueva historia social que se han desarrollado a partir de la historia de la familia. Cuestiones como alianzas matrimoniales, estrategias hereditarias, genealogías sociales, trayectorias familiares e individuales, redes sociales y de patronazgo, ciclo de vida e itinerarios vitales o las formas de convivencia entre otras, permiten adentrarnos en realidades que pueden considerarse exponentes de la intensidad del cambio social. Temas abordados desde las experiencias de familias, individuos o componentes de distintos grupos que evidencian efectivamente una sociedad dinámica pero también diferenciada con ritmos y consecuencias muy

Taking the Vesalian anatomical revolution as its point of departure this volume charts the apparent rise and fall of anatomy studies within universities in sixteenth century Spain focussing particularly on primary sources from 1550 to 1600 In doing so it both clarifies the Spanish contribution to the field of anatomy and disentangles the distorted political and historiographical viewpoints emerging from previous research Studies of early modern Iberian science have only been carried out coherently and collaboratively in the last few decades even though fierce debates on the subject have dominated Spanish historiography for more than two centuries In the field of anatomy studies many uninformed and biased readings of archival sources have resulted in a very confused picture of the practice of dissection and the teaching of anatomy in the Iberian Peninsula in which the highly complex conditions of anatomical research within Spain's national context are often oversimplified The new empirical evidence that this book brings to light suggests a far more multifaceted narrative of Iberian Renaissance anatomy than has been presented to date *Medicine, Government and Public Health in Philip II's Spain* Dr Michele L Clouse, 2013-07-28 Bridging the gap between histories of medicine and political institutional histories of the early modern crown this book explores the relationship between one of the most highly bureaucratic regimes in early modern Europe Spain and crown interest in and regulation of medical practices Complementing recent histories that have emphasized the interdependent nature of governance between the crown and municipalities in sixteenth century Spain this study argues that medical policies were the result of negotiation and cooperation among the crown the towns and medical practitioners During the reign of Philip II 1556-1598 the crown provided unique opportunities for advancements in the medical field among practitioners and support for the creation and dissemination of innovative medical techniques In addition crown support for and regulation of medicine served as an important bureaucratic tool in the crown's effort to expand and solidify its authority over the distinct kingdoms and territories under Castilian authority and the municipalities within the kingdom of Castile itself The crown was not the only agent of change in the medical world however Medical policies and their successful implementation required consensus and cooperation among competing political authorities Bringing to life a cast of characters from early modern Spain from the female empiric who practiced bonesetting and surgery to the university trained Latin physician whose medical textbook standardized medical education in the universities the book will broaden the scope of medical history to include not only the development of medical theory and innovative practice but also address the complex tensions between various authorities which influenced the development and nature of medical practice and perceptions of public health in early modern Europe Juxtaposing the history of medicine with the history of early modern state building brings a unique perspective to this challenging book that reassesses the relationship between the

monarch and intellectual milieu of medicine in Spain It further challenges the dominance of studies of medical regulation from France and England and illuminates a diverse and innovative world of Spanish medical practice that has been neglected in standard histories of early modern medicine
