This condition led to a new definition by Greek philosophers who defined psychology as a 'science of mind'. But this definition was also rejected on the same grounds as soul was rejected.

Later, Wilhelm Wundt a psychologist who established the first psychological laboratory at the University of Leipzig in Germany
