REVIEW ESSAY: HISTORY OF POLITICAL ECONOMY The AEA and the History of Economics

To commemorate its centennial in 1985 the AEA undertook and/or sponsored a variety of activities. From the historian of economics' standpoint by far the most interesting of these, both for its symbolic and its actual value, was the Executive Committee's decision to commission five articles "concerning the history of economics in the United States." The authors were selected by a distinguished panel of economists: George J. Stigler; Moses Abramovitz; and Charles Kindelberger, all ex-Presidents, and the results were duly published in December 1985 as part of a special Supplement to the AEA, which also contained the latest Directory of Members.

For readers of this journal, and, more particularly, from the standpoint of the specialist historian of economics, it is natural to ask why, of the five authors selected for this undertaking only one, Martin Bronfenbrenner, a past President of the History of Economics Society, can be described as a recognized practitioner and expert in the subject? Surely it was incumbent of the Association, through its customary sub-committee procedure, to go to the experts, as one would expect it to do in commissioning essays on specialist topics? Perhaps these are unnecessary, even improper questions, prompted by sour grapes and reflecting a typical trade union demarcationist mentality. After all, most historians of economics are humble, modest toilers in the scholarly vineyard, and unfriendly critics might add - they have plenty to be modest about!

More seriously, however, this group of essays symbolizes the current status of the history of economics in the U.S., and, no doubt, the widespread ignorance of the excellent and wide ranging research activity now in progress (the word is used deliberately). Despite the number of publications in the field, the existence of specialist societies in a number of countries, and the presentation of one hundred forty papers at the latest History of Economics Society meeting, it is still possible for a disginguished and usually well-informed scholar like William Parker to say in print that "the history of economic thought...[which] once formed a part of the basic culture of every economist, is now almost completely defunct." Ironically this is part of his introductory "history of economics in a nutshell," as described and warmly praised by James Tobin, one of the authors of the five AEA essays reviewed here.

Given this background, my response to the AEA articles is unequivocally ambivalent, if the expression is permissible. On the one hand it is always a pleasure (or almost always!) to see leading economists taking a genuine interest in their discipline's history as--let it be said--all good economists should. On the other hand, one has the right to expect that ventures into this area should be taken seriously, and not in the "idiosyncratic" (i.e., casual, cf p. 11) manner demonstrated by William J. Baumol, in this paper, "On Method in U.S. Economics a Century Earlier," which will be considered more fully below. Bronfenbrenner's provocative paper "Early American Leaders - Institutional and Critical Traditions" is also characteristically idiosyncratic, and much space
