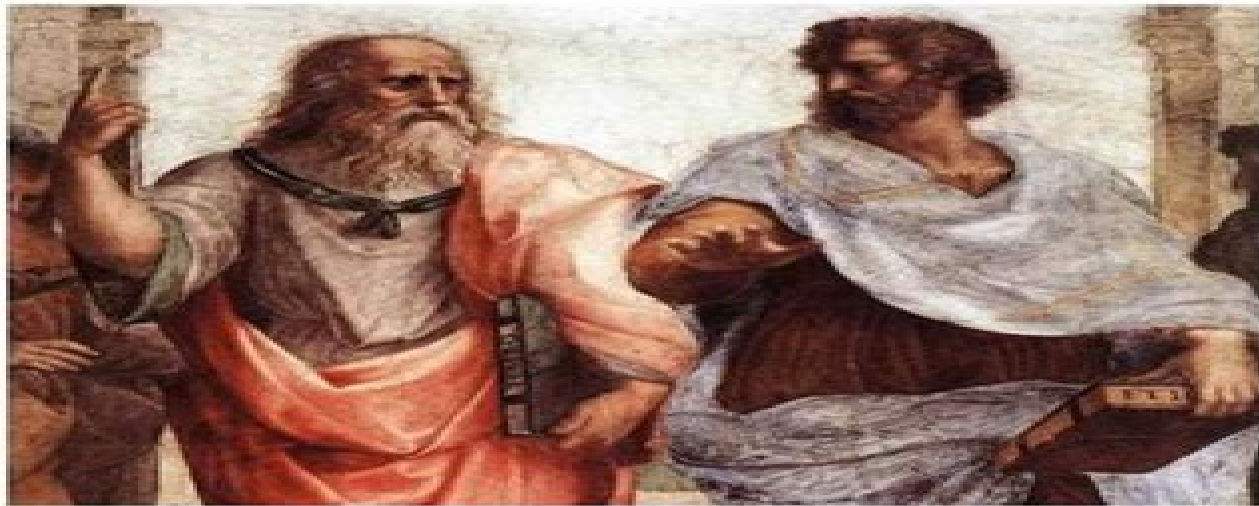

Empiricists preserve an empiricist road to first principles by downplaying enumerative induction's role. In order to preserve Aristotle's avowals that it is by induction that we know the principles while avoiding the rationalist alternative, David Botting provides an inferentialist account of induction showing how the content of a first principle is inferentially known but not its necessity, which must be proved by constructing the first principle from simpler elements.
