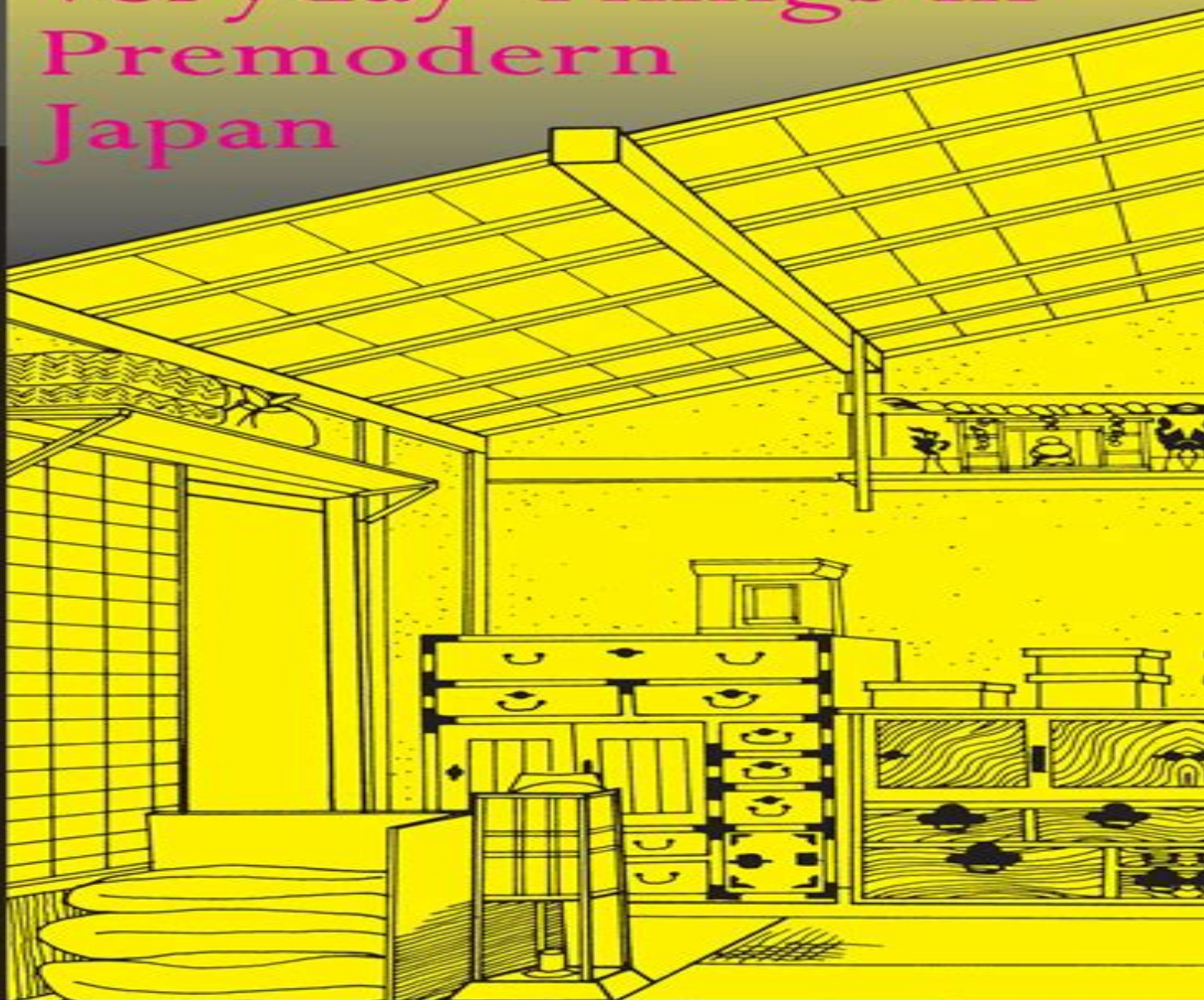

lack of sanitary conditions that increased the likelihood of disease outbreak While life was harsh for almost all people from 700 to 1150 these experiences represented investments in human capital that would bear fruit during the medieval epoch 1150 1600
