# Circum-Mediterranean Neogene (Miocene and Pliocene) Marine— Continental Chronologic Correlations of European Mammal Units

This paper is an update of Steininges et al. 1989. It is mainly concerned with the chronologic correlation of the Miscene and Pliocene European Mammal Biosonations, the "European Neogene Mammal Faunal Zones" (MN zones, for documion see Steininger et al. 1989) and the "European Mammal Faunal Units" (Agense, Orleanie, etc., of Fahlburch 1975; for discussion see Steininger et al. 1989), with the new Geomagnetic Polarity Time Scale (Cande and Kent 1992; in press) and the revised Geomagnetic Polarity Time Scale, Cenozoic Geochionology, Chronostratigraphy, and Planktonic Foruminifera Zonation (Benggren et al., in press).

Within the last years tapid progress has been made in dating mammal-bearing Misocore and Plicocre sediments, either by radioisotopic dating (see also Swither et al., this volume) and/or by geomagnetic dating (see also the following articles in this volume: Bernor et al., Kappelman et al.; Sen; and Woodburne et al.). These recent results have been incorporated into this new data base. For a more recent compilation of the Pleistocene record see Agusti 1991 and Arusti et al. 1987.

Neogene Chronostratigraphy

A three-fold subdivision of the Miocene is generally accepted by most stratigraphers (Berggren et al. 1985a, b). The relationship between calcareous plankton biostratigraphy and standard chromostratigraphic units was discussed at length in Berggren et al. 1985a and 1985b, and the scader is referred to that source for background information. We review here only several (minor) adjustments and/ or studies that have been made since 1985.

The Paleogene/Neogene Working Group of the IUGS Neogene Subcommission (under the leadership of Fritz F. Steininger) has been focusing on the definition of a GSSP (Global Stratignaphic Section and Point) for the Neogene and the Paleogene/Neogene boundary for over a decade, and the Paleogene/Neogene boundary for over a decade, lit has recently been decided (Steininger et al. 1994) to recommend that the GSSP be located at the 35-m level of the Rigoroso Formation in the Lemme-Carrosio section of NE Italy corresponding to the base of Chron G6Cn.2n and the FAD of Globorotolia higher with an age estimate of 23.8 Ma (Carole and Kerst, in press; Berggen et al., in press; Hodell and Woodruff 1994). Janis, Juha Saarinen, 2023-08-08 This volume presents an array of different case studies which take as primary material data sourced from the NOW New and Old Worlds database of fossil mammals The NOW database was one of the very first large paleobiological databases and since 1996 it has been expanded from including mainly Neogene European land mammals to cover the entire Cenozoic at a global scale In the last two decades the number of works that are based in the use of huge databases to explore ecological and evolutionary questions has increased exponentially and even though the importance of big data in paleobiological research has been outlined in selected chapters of general works no volume has appeared before this one which solely focuses on the databases as a primary source in reconstructing the past The purpose of this book is to provide an illustrative volume showing the importance of big data in paleobiological research and presenting a broad array of unpublished examples and case studies The book is mainly aimed to professional palaeobiologists working with Cenozoic land mammals but the scope of the book is broad enough to fit the interest for evolutionary biologists paleoclimatologists and paleoecologists. The volume is divided in four parts The first part includes two chapters on the development of large paleobiological databases providing a first hand account on the logic and the functioning of these databases This is a much needed perspective which is ignored by most researchers and users of such databases and even if centered in the NOW database the lessons that can be learned from this part can be extended to other examples After this introductory part the body of the book follows and is divided into three parts patterns in regional faunas large scale patterns and processes and ecological biogeographical and evolutionary patterns of key taxa Each chapter is written by well known specialists in the field with some participation of members of the NOW advisory board The array of selected mammal taxa ranges from carnivores equids ruminants and rodents to the genus Homo The topics studied also include the diversification and radiation of major clades large scale paleobiogeographical patterns the evolution of ecomorphological patterns and paleobiological problems such as evolution of body size or species longevity In most cases the results are discussed in relation to protracted environmental or paleogeographic changes
