importantly security income and the adoption of democratic norms It is this key dynamic that explains why insurgency poverty and under development do not have a linearly negative effect on democracy Instead these factors have a centripetal effect on political development pulling a country s government towards an intermediate state of political transition in which regimes stagnate in a partially democratic partially autocratic regime type Conversely the model also explains why high income democratic norms and security do not necessarily lead to democratization in all cases
