Throughout the Two Lands, Upper Egypt and Lower Egypt, it was understood that building a Pyramid was a sign of love and respect for the Pharaoh.

Inside the pyramids there were courtyards, storage rooms, lofty halls, and secret passageways. The walls of each room were covered with paintings, relief sculptures, and hieroglyphic writing that told about the life and times of the person buried inside. The rooms were filled with beautiful statues and clothes, and gold plated toys and games and trinkets, and anything else the pharaoh might want to have on hand in his or her afterlife.



## MASTABA

Egyptologists use the Arabic word mastaba, meaning bench, that is made of mud brick, and for the massive rectangular structures with sloping sides, and a flat roof found above many tombs, in Sappara, Giza, and other places. Menes was the first pharaoh of Egypt, uniting Upper & Lower Egypt into a single kingdom.

## STEP

The Step Pyramid was built during the Third Dynasty as the tomb for Pharaoh Djoser. It was designed by the famous architect, Imhotep, who was later deified. A step pyramid or stepped pyramid is an architectural structure that uses flat platforms, or steps, receding from the ground up, to achieve a completed shape similar to a geometric pyramid.
