

in it an exceedingly interesting chapter on gem cutting But the volume was written about 75 years ago probably had a very limited circulation was never reprinted and not one library in fifty ever heard of it That is the only volume the Author has ever found that treats even briefly of gem cutting This excludes of course such texts as The Gem Cutters Craft by Leopold Cleremont which have chapters on the technique of cutting but that treat of it so generally that they cannot be used as instructions.
