Polkinghorne, 2014-07-14 Is it possible to think like a scientist and yet have the faith of a Christian Although many Westerners might say no there are also many critically minded individuals who entertain what John Polkinghorne calls a wistful wariness toward religion they feel unable to accept religion on rational grounds yet cannot
