Legh's detailed research utilises a range of government documents, personal papers, parliamentary debates, and newspapers to provide this crucial re-assessment of the Conservative Party and selective education, and in doing so, questions over simplistic generalisations about wholesale support for selective education policy. It reveals instead questioning, compromises, and disagreements within the Party and its political and ideological allies. The result is a stimulating revival of existing scholarship which will be of interest to scholars of British education and politics.
