

Longstreet whose legacy fell victim to bitter postwar Southern politics when Old Pete supported Reconstruction bills accepted postings with the Grant Administration and criticized Robert E Lee Many modern writers continue to skew the general s legacy This book draws heavily upon 20th century U S Army doctrine field training staff planning command and

combat experience and is the first serious treatment of Longstreet's generalship vis a vis modern warfare Not everyone will agree with Knudsen's conclusions but it will now be impossible to write about the general without referencing this important study
