Tetlow, 1992 Many scholars consider *In Our Time* to be Hemingway's finest work, yet the cohesiveness of this sequence of stories and interchapters has often been questioned. Hemingway himself, however, had a clear idea of the work's integrity, as his manuscripts and letters reveal. As he wrote to his publisher Horace Liveright on 31 March 1925: "There is nothing in the book that has not a definite place in its organization, and if I at any time seem to repeat myself, I have a good reason for doing so." *Selected Letters*, 154.
