


chained him and other ringleaders to the quarterdeck. Fearing efforts to rescue the prisoners, officers had to stay awake in round the clock watches. Steering desperately for land, sleep deprived and armed to the teeth, battling efforts to liberate Spencer Somers's captain and officers finally faced a fateful choice: somehow keep control of the vessel until reaching port, still hundreds of miles away, or hang the midshipman and his two leading henchmen before the boys could take over the ship. The results shook the nation. A naval investigation of the affair turned into a court martial and a state trial and led to the founding of the Naval Academy to provide better officers for the still young republic. Mackenzie's controversial decision may have inspired Herman Melville's great work *Billy Budd*.
