She attended London's public schools, a French convent in Italy, and finishing schools in Paris and Beverly. She joined the Academy of Dramatic Art in London when 17. Her first legitimate stage role was in "The Green Bush," followed by "The Mask of Virtue," "The Happy Hypocrite," and "Henry VIII." "You Came England" was her first major picture, followed by "Dark Journey," "There Is A Tower," "St. Martin's Lane" and "A Tale of Two Cities." Meanwhile on the London stage she played "Rise for The Money," "Hamlet" and "A Midsummer Night's Dream." Her casting as Scarlett O'Hara happened fortuitously. After all efforts and time had been made with the most well known David O. Selznick actually started showing his picture without her name. Miss Leigh was a guest witness at the opening when the producer was struck by her resemblance to the Scarlett as described by Miss Mitchell.
