Using new models of stakeholder theory, the discussion compares four case studies: the extension of DHL at Brussels National Airport, the industrial cluster on the Left Bank of the port of Antwerp, the plan for the port of Brussels to be completed in 2015 and the plan for the port of Antwerp to be completed in 2030.
