A. In the conflict between freedom and order, liberals (Democrats) are more likely to advocate (favor) a *br-o-a-d* interpretation of the Constitution's guarantees of rights and liberties to ensure the individual's right to act free of gov't restraint

in political and social affairs; however... conservatives (Republicans) are more likely to interpret those same constitutional guarantees more *narrowly* so that gov't may act to preserve the established political and social order.
