Going Native Or Going Naive? Dagmar Wernitznig, 2003 *Going Native or Going Naive* is a critical analysis of an esoteric Indian movement called white shamanism. This movement originating from the 1980s New Age boom redefines the phenomenon of playing Indian. For white shamans and their followers, Indianness turns into a signifier for cultural cloning.
