Edmund Pendleton was a Virginia planter politician lawyer and judge He served in the Virginia legislature before and during the American Revolutionary War rising to the postion of Speaker Pendleton attended the First Continental Congress as one of Virginia s delegates alongside George Washington and Patrick Henry and led the conventions both wherein Virginia declared indepence 1776 and adopted the United States Constitution 1788 Pendleton was a moderate who initially hoped for reconciliation rather than revolt With Thomas Jefferson and George Wythe Pendleton revised Virginia s legal code after the The Virginia Statute for Religious Freedom Merrill D.
