famous for the part he played in helping Archie MacLaren s eleven to defeat Warwick Armstrong s previously invincible 1921 tourists Informed opinion suggests that his refusal to play for Middlesex cost him the chance to play Test cricket but his loyalty to Norfolk was paramount and he never expressed any regrets As a Tory M P and a landowning grandee one might expect him to have been a somewhat remote and forbidding character but he was a quiet and modest man with a love of the game which gave him a bond with the common cricketer On one occasion he was more than ready to lead a singalong with the players of a village cricket club Stephen Musk tells a story of privilege public service and the pastime of cricket
