
HEALTH OF GULF WAR AND GULF WAR ERA VETERANS

In 1995, VA conducted a survey study on the health of a sample of 15,000 Gulf War Veterans (deployed) and 15,000 Gulf War Era Veterans (non-deployed). VA followed up with these Veterans with another survey in 2012–2013 to learn about their recent physical and mental health. About half of the Veterans responded. The survey

results indicate that more than 20 years after the war, Veterans who were deployed continue to report poorer health than Veterans who did not deploy. The average number of self-reported chronic medical conditions was 3.5 (3.7 in deployed Veterans and 2.9 in non-deployed Veterans).

MENTAL HEALTH DISORDERS

The survey included screening questions to see if Veterans may have certain mental health conditions.

45% of study participants screened positive for at least one mental health condition (52% in deployed Veterans and 39% in non-deployed Veterans).
