film actors and artists and the creative refugees who were drawn to Hollywood and Southern California in these years Igor Stravinsky Arnold Schoenberg Man Ray Bertolt Brecht Christopher Isherwood Aldous Huxley Thomas Mann and Franz Werfel Starr gives a fascinating account of how many of them attempted to recreate their European world in California and how others like Samuel Goldwyn provided stories and dreams for their adopted nation Starr reserves his greatest attention and most memorable writing for San Francisco For Starr despite the city's beauty and commercial importance San Francisco's most important achievement was the sense of well being it conferred on its citizens It was a city that magically belonged to everyone Whether discussing photographers like Edward Weston and Ansel Adams hard boiled fiction writers or the new breed of female star Marlene Dietrich Jean Harlow Bette Davis Carole Lombard and the improbable Mae West *The Dream Endures* is a brilliant social and cultural history in many ways the most far reaching and important of Starr's California books
