Der Band macht die Genese des Romans aus den beiden Vorarbeiten Die stille Revolution und Krieg ohne Kriegserklärung und den drei Konzeptionen Ein Soldat seiner Zeit, Ein Soldat der Diktatur und Ein Kind unserer Zeit nachvollziehbar. Er liefert einen umfassenden Einblick in die komplexe Werkgenese des Romans in der handschriftlichen Entwürfe und Typoskripte, oft parallel entstanden sind. Da das Einreichmanuskript des Romans nicht berücksichtigt ist, basiert die Endfassung auf dem von Horváth autorisierten Erstdruck. Alle Abweichungen dazu finden sich im kritischen Apparat verzeichnet. So wird der Roman erstmals in seiner ganzen Entstehungsgeschichte und in seiner ursprünglichen Fassung lesbar.
