Loyalist lawyers and lawyers for the crown also participated in this public discourse but because they lost out in the end, their arguments are often slighted or ignored in popular accounts. This division within the colonial legal profession is central to understanding the American Republic that resulted from the Revolution.

Edmund Pendleton was a Virginia planter politician lawyer and judge He served in the Virginia legislature before and during the American Revolutionary War rising to the position of Speaker Pendleton attended the First Continental Congress as one of Virginia's delegates alongside George Washington and Patrick Henry and led the conventions both wherein Virginia declared independence 1776 and adopted the United States Constitution 1788 Pendleton was a moderate who initially hoped for reconciliation rather than revolt With Thomas Jefferson and George Wythe Pendleton revised Virginia's legal code after the break with Britain
