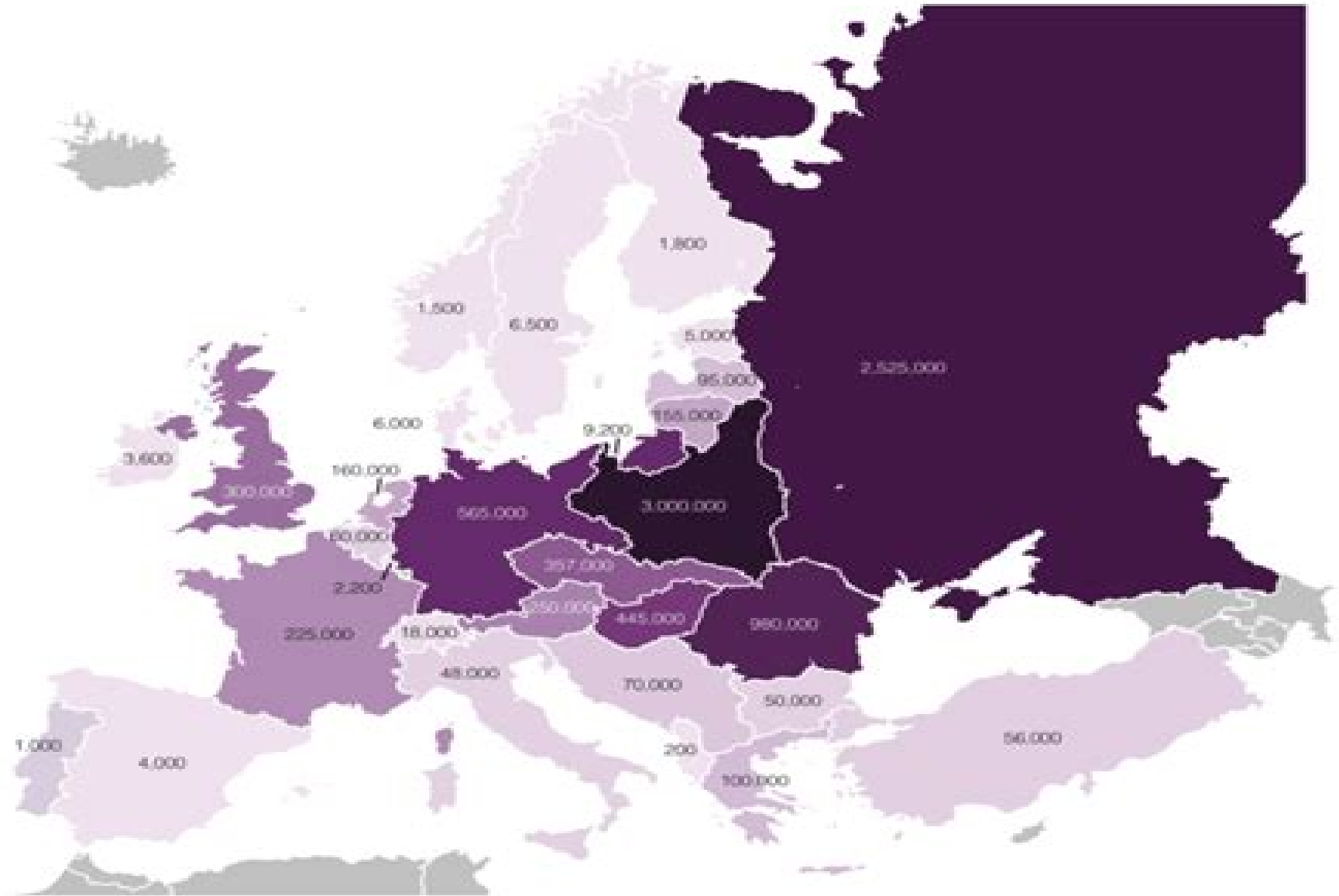


Jewish Population in Europe, 1933
