Although P ezuela's overthrow was organized and carried out by royalists among the merchants and the military, it proved to be an important event in the development of the independence movement as well as a pivotal factor in the failure to establish a stable national state in post-independence Peru. The golpe de estado may thereby be seen as an early manifestation of Latin American praetorianism in which a sector of the civilian population, unable to prevail politically and unwilling to compromise, pressures army officers to act in order to save the state.
