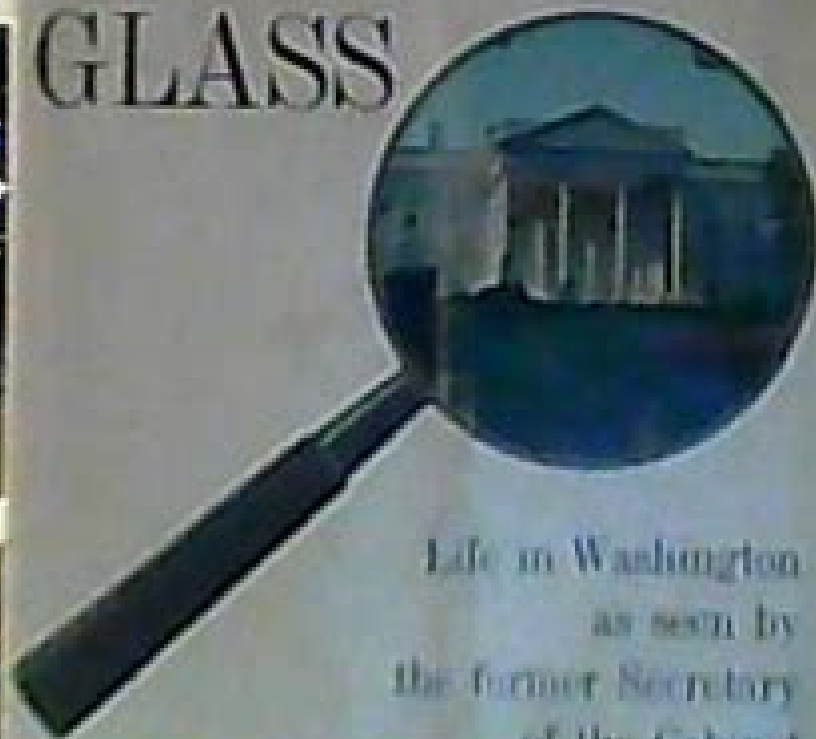

Bush achieve his dream of becoming president in 2000 by reaching out to gay and lesbian supporters the first time a Republican candidate for president formally met with gay and lesbian Americans. This inspired Francis to engage with deleted LGBTQ history by forming a historical society with an edge: a new Mattachine Society of Washington DC. For the first time, *Archive Activism* reveals how LGBTQ secrets were held for decades at the LBJ Presidential Library in the papers of President Johnson's personal secretary, sealed until her death at age 105. Mattachine's signature discovery is a federal attorney's classified assault, blandly filed under Suitability at the National Archives. What it boils down to is that most men look upon homosexuality as something uniquely nasty. *Archive Activism* is not only a memoir but also an essential roadmap for activists from any group armed only with their library cards.
