

Gallant Canadians Daniel George Dancocks, 1990 During the Great War of 1914 1919 sic the Tenth Canadian Infantry Battalion acquired a reputation for excellence Nicknamed the Fighting Tenth the Battalion took part in every major Canadian battle of the war Festubert Mount Sorrel the Somme Vimy Ridge Arleux Hill 70 Passchendaele Amiens the Drocourt Queant Line and the Canal du Nord In the process the Battalion won two Victoria Crosses along with a host of other decorations for bravery including eighteen DSOs sixty four MCs sixty seven DCMs and 289 MMs But the cost was high In the course of the war 5390 men from all parts of Canada served in the unit 85 per cent became casualties Despite the heavy losses the Battalion displayed remarkable power of recovery Inside dust jacket cover Gallant Canadians Daniel G.
