The existence of erratic blocks and the disappearance of mammoths are presented as evidence of the last glaciation. However despite dating obtained by 14C calibrated by dendrochronology is considered absolute by most experts its confrontation with the Egyptian chronology in which some dates are fixed by astronomy reverses this widespread belief and shows that dates obtained by 14C increase exponentially before 2200 Thus the rate of 14C tends gradually to 0 around 3500 which implies an important consequence before 3500 14C dating is no longer possible
