Benjamin Emphasizing the role played by the new technologies of sight and sound she is able to suggest the nature of the long repressed cultural and political climate that produced French fascism and to show by implication that the mass marketing of ideology in democratic states bears a family resemblance to the fascist mode of an earlier time
