Primicias de la cultura de Quito el inicio del periodismo en el Ecuador fue replicada treinta y seis años después en Cuenca cuando fray Vicente Solano puso a circular *El Eco del Asuay* sic el primer periódico que salió a la luz en nuestra aún balbuciente vida republicana. Era el domingo 13 de enero de 1828 días en los que bullían las ambiciones y tambaleaba la Gran Colombia. Se trataba de un impreso en folio de cuatro páginas a dos columnas de edición clara y limpia y en cuya primera página ostentaba un epígrafe tomado de una frase de Rousseau que decía: *Ce n'est pas assez de dire aux citoyens soyez bons il faut leur apprendre le bien*. No basta decir a los ciudadanos sed buenos es necesario enseñarles a serlo. Era evidente que en la naciente república corrían nuevos aires los ideales de la Ilustración habían permeado en la mentalidad de los nuevos líderes de la sociedad. defeat But this was nothing new Heilman reveals that minute divides inside rural indigenous communities repeatedly led to violent conflict across the twentieth century
