Most of the women are found to be employed in agricultural activities and in the unorganized sector. The employment of women is high in the unorganized sector such as part time helpers in households, construction center, match and beedi industries etc. An estimate by the world bank show that 90% of the women working in the unorganized sector are not included in the official statistics and then work is undocumented and considered as disguised wage work unskilled, low paying and do not provide benefits to the workers.
