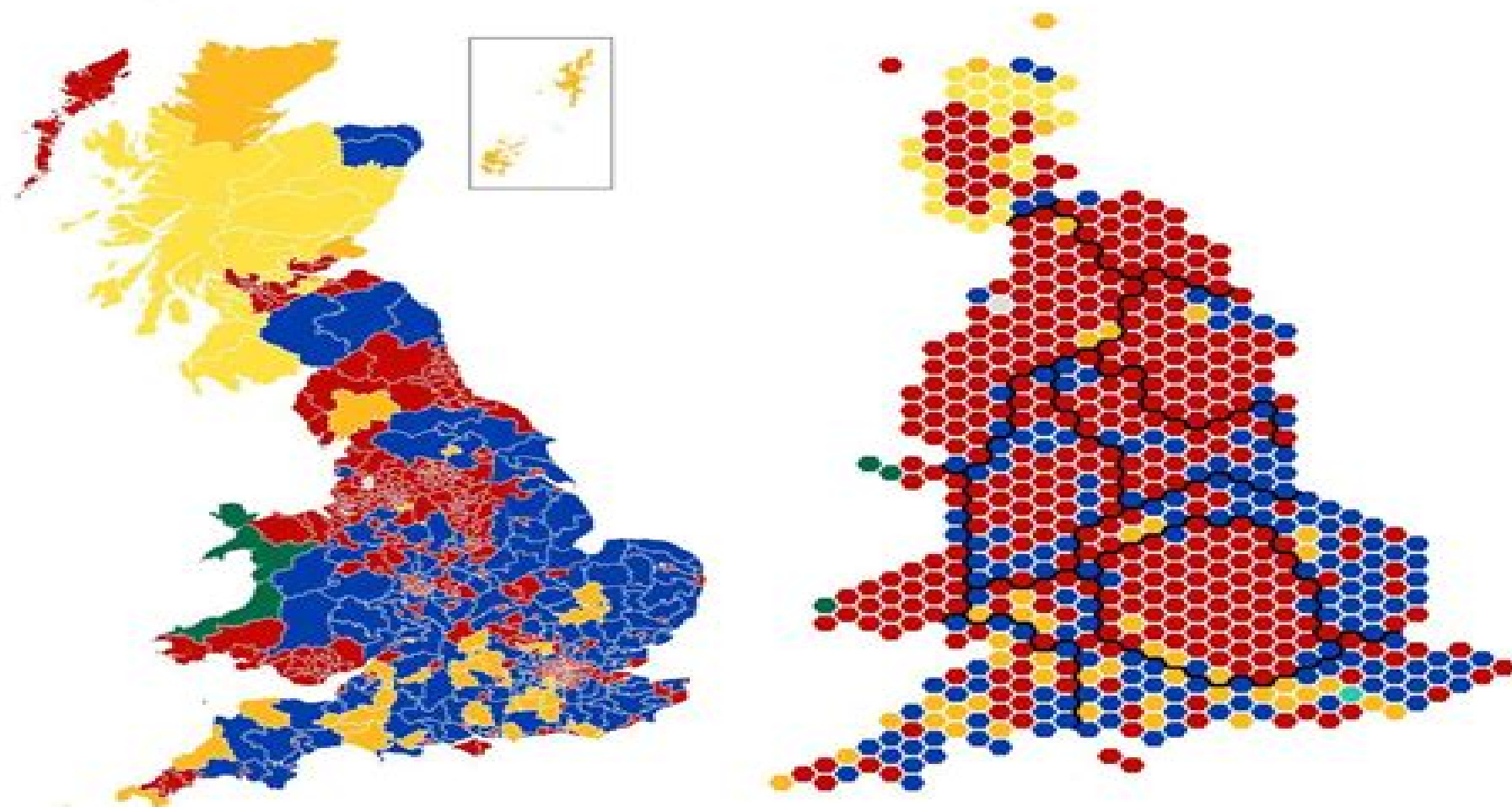


YouGov MRP shows Labour would win landslide majority akin to 1997 if election were held tomorrow
